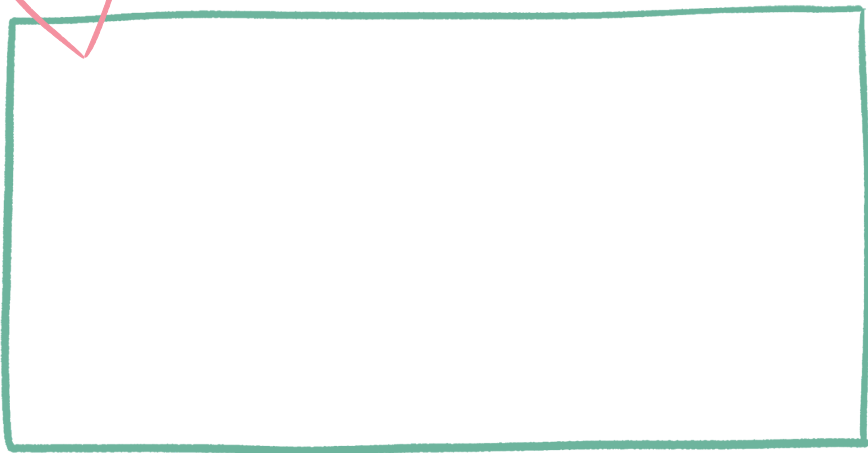
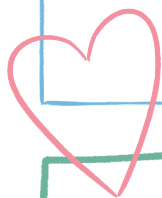
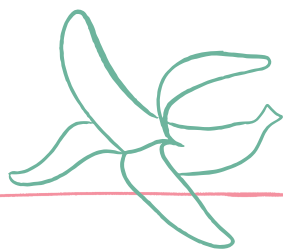
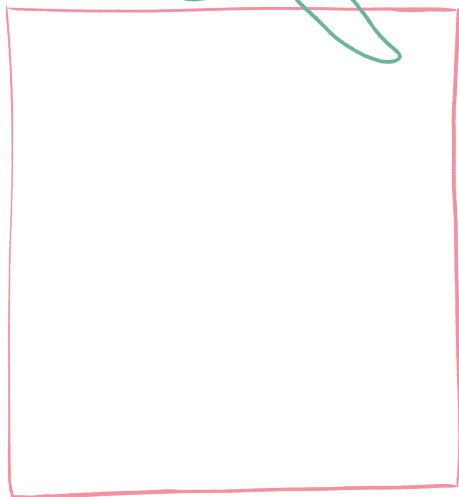
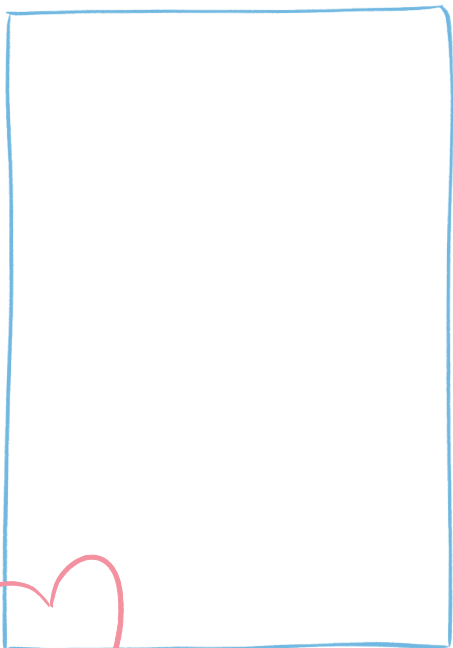
# DRAW

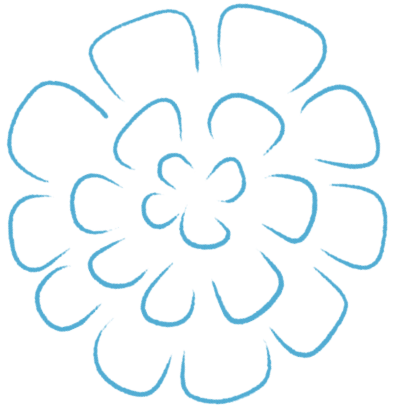

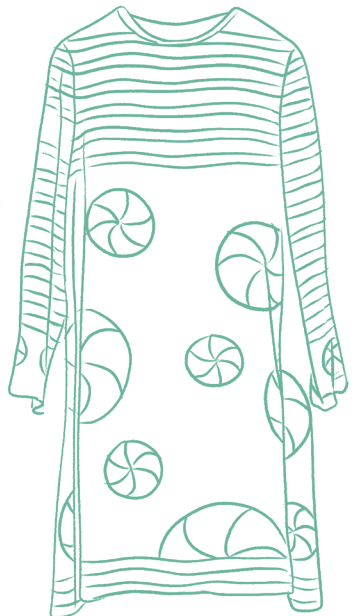

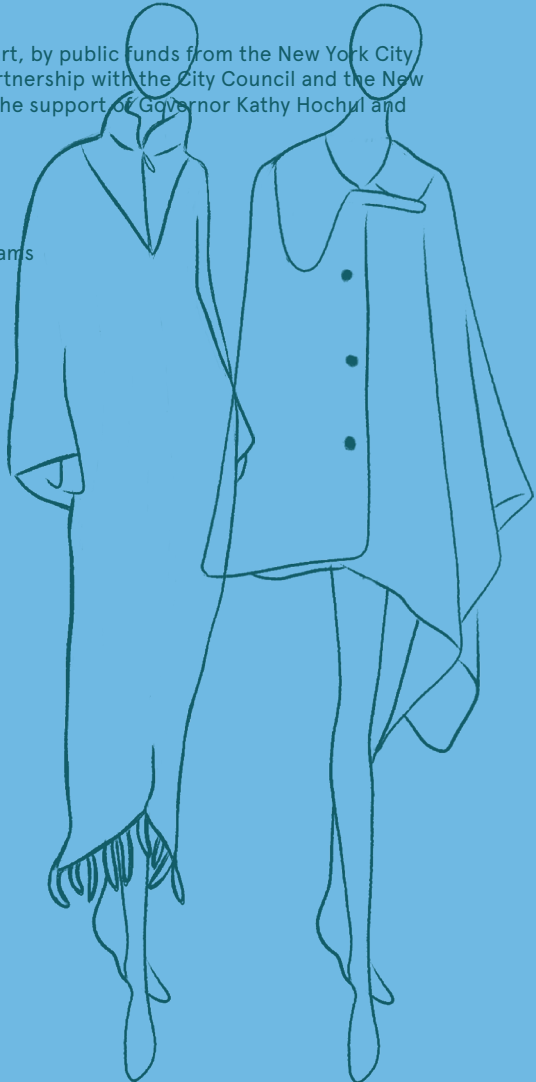
