We are seeking additional per diem educators to conduct onsite tours for adult groups of the Museum's special exhibitions and collection exhibition. Some virtual teaching opportunities will also be available.

Responsibilities

- Conduct gallery talks (either onsite and/or online) on a range of topics related to the Jewish Museum's collection and special exhibitions
- Conduct art historical research and prepare PowerPoint presentations independently
- Attend occasional in person and virtual training sessions. All sessions will be recorded for future reference

- Deep knowledge of art history
- Knowledge of ancient, medieval, modern, and/or contemporary art preferred
- Five or more years related experience working in museums and/or teaching art history
